Clothing	Polo or other collared shirt and khakis or dress pants. Closed toe dress shoes. NO jeans or athletic shoes. School logo, contestant name or other identifiers on shirt must be covered. Or SkillsUSA Official Attire: Official SkillsUSA Red Blazer, white shirt, black pants or skirt, and black shoes. Black socks must be worn with pants and nylons must be worn with a skirt (either skin-tone or black). Males must wear a tie.
Testing	 Students should be prepared to take a written knowledge test for this contest. Students should also be prepared to take a SkillsUSA written knowledge test (required for all contestants).

Additional software allowed for support files [NOT TO BE USED FOR PRIMARY LAYOUT PURPOSES]: Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, Macromedia Freehand and Painter. Computer portion of the contest Contestant will need to know how to do a page layout which includes placing items from a disk, doing color separations, sizing, text wrap, reverse, crop, scale, rotate, etc. Drawn/Written Work: <u>Mandatory</u> Assorted colored pencils, graphite pencils + erasers Sketchbook or paper Drawing/Marker/Graphics Pad Rulers **Optional** Ink+ technical pens Drawing Tablet – No iPad Written portion of the contest Written test will be distributed. This will be an advertising and design general knowledge test. The contest area is CLOSED to observers.
