Only dues-paid members of SkillsUSA may enter. The final deadline to register for the competition is March 24, 2023. Due to space limitations, we can allow a maximum of 100 students to participate • <i>A maximum of ten students per school may enter.</i>
Clothing	<p><u>Business Casual:</u> Polo or other collared shirt and khakis or dress pants; NO JEANS. If a school logo, contestant name, or other identifier is listed on the shirt this must be covered.</p>
Testing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students should be prepared for a written SkillsUSA knowledge test. (Test provided to all contestants).

Special Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Exhibit Halls do not open to observers until 12:00pm. ▪ No smart watches, earbuds, and phones are permitted during the contest and/or in contest ▪ No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins ▪ No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contest ▪ No cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing.
