Clothing	Official SkillsUSA Dress: Official SkillsUSA Red Blazer, white shirt, black pants or skirt, and black dress shoes. Black socks must be worn with pants and nylons must be worn with a skirt (either skin-tone or black). Males must wear a tie.
Testing	 Students should be prepared for a SkillsUSA written knowledge test (Required for all contestants prior to contest day)
Provided by Contestant (Tool List)	 One hard copy of a 1-page typed personal resume All tools necessary to assemble and set up their display 25' UL approved extension cord, if display requires electricity A letter signed by the local school administrator verifying that display was designed and built by students must accompany each display in an official one-inch SkillsUSA 3-ring binder and must be the first page of the notebook An official SkillsUSA 1" 3-ring binder Notebook limited to 12 pages (24 surfaces) Displays requiring tables will need to bring their own table

• The SkillsUSA competition theme for the 2022-2023 school year is:


