

Emergency Medical Technician



Purpose: To evaluate each contestant's ability to react positively in simulated situations demanding Emergency Medical Technician intervention and to recognize excellence and professionalism in the career and technical student's first aid skills.

Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Please refer to the National Technical Standards for this contest. ▪ Schools may send one competitor or team for every 50 paid SkillsUSA members based on local competition enrolled in a program where the scope of the contest described in the SkillsUSA Technical Content Standards reflects a major component of the program. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Team of 2 (two)</i>
Clothing	<p><u>Business Casual:</u></p> <p>Polo or other collared shirt and khakis or dress pants; NO JEANS. If a school logo, contestant name, or other identifier is listed on the shirt this must be covered.</p> <p>OR</p> <p><u>Work/School Attire:</u></p> <p>School uniform with all identifying logos/markers covered. Field specific work clothing required for the work environment or that matches the service conditions for the contest. This may include jeans if they are clean and professional looking and are accepted in the respective field (no holes or overly soiled pants). Work shoes or boots with hard sole or anti-slip properties (steel toes may be required- refer to Provided by Contestant section below). Clothing should be as such that it will not get caught in moving equipment or power tools. School uniforms may be worn if they meet the above requirements with all identifiers covered.</p>
Testing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students should be prepared to take a written knowledge test. • Students should be prepared to take a written SkillsUSA knowledge test. (Required for all contestants prior to contest day).

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Personal protective equipment to include one (1) box of disposable medical exam gloves, two (2) pair of eye protection, four (4) surgical masks, and pocket mask or another appropriate barrier device. ▪ 25 4x4 bandages ▪ Three (3) rolls self-adhering roller bandages ▪ Four (4) triangular bandages ▪ Medical tape ▪ Two (2) Occlusive dressing ▪ Four (4) 5x9 abdominal dressing ▪ One (1) Trauma dressing ▪ Two (2) Flexible (Sam) Splint ▪ Trauma shears or medical scissors ▪ Pen Light ▪ Stethoscope (one per team) ▪ Blood pressure Cuff (one per team) ▪ Oral and nasal airway (Compete set of each) ▪ Adult Bag Value Mask (BVM) ▪ EMS or tactical emergency tourniquet) <p>**NOTE: Any other items brought by the contestant will be subject to the approval of the Technical Committee and must be declared at the time of the on-site check</p>
<p>Special Notes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Exhibit Halls do not open to observers until 12:00 pm. ▪ To enter the contest area, contestants must show one of the following: ▪ Approved Basic Life Support (BLS) certifications from: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • American Red Cross • American Heart Association • American Safety Institute • National Safety Council ▪ No smart watches, earbuds, or phones are permitted during the contest and/or in contest. ▪ No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins. ▪ No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contest. ▪ No cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing.
