Clothing	Official SkillsUSA Dress: Official SkillsUSA Red Blazer, white shirt, black pants or skirt, and black dress shoes. Black socks must be worn with pants and nylons must be worn with a skirt (either skin-tone or black). Males must wear a tie.
Testing	 Students should be prepared to take a SkillsUSA written knowledge test (Required for all contestants prior to contest day).
Provided by Contestant (Tool List)	 Business plans presented at the competition must be in a hard three-ring binder, along with a PDF format and saved and named as the business name or idea and submitted prior to the competition. One hard copy of a 1-page typed personal résumé. All materials and supplies needed for their presentation. Competitors need to bring everything they need for the presentation. Ex. Laptop, charger, cords, clickers, adapter, any visual aids, hotspot (if Wi-Fi not provided), etc.
Special Notes	 This contest is CLOSED. No smart watches, phones, or earbuds are permitted during the contest and/or in contest. No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contest No cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing.
