Eligibility	 Please refer to the National Technical Standards for this contest. May send 2 (two) competitors per school.

Testing	 Students should be prepared to take a written knowledge test. Students should be prepared to take a written SkillsUSA knowledge test. (Required for all contestants prior to contest day).
Provided by Contestant (Tool List)	 One hard copy of a 1-page typed personal resume Competitors are required to bring a desktop or laptop computer preloaded with Adobe Creative Suites (InDesign, Illustrator and Photoshop) w/USB drive. Make sure the Adobe software has been used within a week of the competition in order for it to be accessible. There will be no internet access issues during the competition.
Special Notes	 Exhibit Halls do not open to observers until 12:00 pm. Please ensure you have tried and tested CAD software when disconnected from your school's WIFI. If necessary, plan to bring a hotspot to the contest. TEST THIS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL. The contest may include these components (not an all-inclusive list) Interview/Graphic Design project (Adobe In-Design based) Tri-Fold project (Adobe In-Design based) Print Production/Press Operations No smart watches, earbuds, or phones are permitted during the contest and/or in contest No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contest
