Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Please refer to the National Technical Standards for this contest. ▪ Schools may send one competitor or team for every 50 paid SkillsUSA members based on local competition enrolled in a program where the scope of the contest described in the SkillsUSA Technical Content Standards reflects a major component of the program. ▪ REGIONAL QUALIFIER – ONLY THE TOP 3 (THREE) FROM REGIONAL COMPETITION PROCEED TO STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS
Clothing	<p><u>Business Dress Casual:</u></p> <p>Polo or other collared shirt and khakis or dress pants. Closed toe dress shoes. NO jeans or athletic shoes. School logo, contestant name or other identifiers on shirt must be covered.</p>
Testing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students should be prepared to take a written knowledge test. ▪ Students should be prepared to take a written SkillsUSA knowledge test. (Required for all contestants prior to contest day)
Provided by Contestant (Tool List)	<p><u>Documentation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ One hard copy of a 1-page typed personal resume <p><u>Personal Tools</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Competitors are required to bring an Emergency Medical Form.
Special Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Exhibit Halls do not open to observers until 12:00 pm. ▪ No smart watches, phones, or earbuds are permitted during the contest and/or in contest. ▪ No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins ▪ No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contest

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ No cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing. ▪ Contest will include four to eight troubleshooting stations.
National Technical Standards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Please refer to the 2022-2023 National Technical Standards for all contests. Any and all standards included may be tested in any competition. ▪ In conjunction with National Standards, violations may result in student loss of contest.
Resume	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All SkillsUSA Ohio State Championship Contest will require a short interview component. Students should be prepared with basic job interview skills. • All contestants must have a hard copy of a one (1) page personal resume.
