Clothing	<p>Official Dress:</p> <p>Official SkillsUSA red blazer, white shirt, black pants or skirt, and black dress shoes. Black socks must be worn with pants and nylons must be worn with a skirt (either skin-tone or black). Males must wear a black tie.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>School Uniform appropriate to the contest:</p> <p>Professional attire worn in the classroom such as a criminal justice uniform, chef attire, health scrubs or cosmetology scrubs with all identifiers covered. This includes shoes.</p> <p>Note: Contestants must wear their official contest clothing to the contest orientation meeting.</p>
Testing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students should be prepared to take a SkillsUSA written knowledge test (Required for all contestants prior to contest day).
Provided by Contestant (Tool List)	<p><u>Documentation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ One hard copy of a 1-page typed personal resume.

	<p><u>Personal Tools</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All materials and equipment needed for the demonstration to be completed two times, once for the preliminaries and again for the finals, if required.
Special Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ This contest is open to all observers. ▪ No smart watches, earbuds and/or phones are permitted during the contest. ▪ No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins ▪ No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contestant ▪ No cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing.
