

# Job Skills Demo Open



**PURPOSE:** To evaluate each contestant’s ability to demonstrate and explain an entry-level technical skill either used in the occupational area for which he or she is training or outside his or her training area.

<p><b>Eligibility</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Please refer to the National Technical Standards for this contest.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Leadership and Occupationally Related Contest Specifications - The following competitions are open to all members of SkillsUSA Schools may send one competitor or team for every 500 SkillsUSA members based on local competition.</li> <li>• REGIONAL QUALIFIER – ONLY THE TOP 3 (THREE) FROM REGIONAL COMPETITION PROCEED TO STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>Clothing</b></p>	<p>Official Dress:</p> <p>Official SkillsUSA red blazer, white shirt, black pants or skirt, and black dress shoes. Black socks must be worn with pants and nylons must be worn with a skirt (either skin-tone or black). Males must wear a black tie.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>School Uniform appropriate to the contest:</p> <p>Professional attire worn in the classroom such as a criminal justice uniform, chef attire, health scrubs or cosmetology scrubs with all identifiers covered. This includes shoes.</p> <p>Note: Contestants must wear their official contest clothing to the contest orientation meeting.</p>
<p><b>Testing</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Students should be prepared to take a SkillsUSA written knowledge test. (Required for all contestants prior to contest day)</li> </ul>

<p><b>Provided by Contestant (Tool List)</b></p>	<p>Documentation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ One hard copy of a 1 page typed personal resume</li> </ul> <p>Personal Tools</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ All materials and equipment needed for the demonstration to be completed two times, once for the preliminaries and again for the finals, if required.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Special Notes</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>This contest is open to all observers.</b></li> <li>▪ No smart watches, earbuds, or phones are permitted during the contest.</li> <li>▪ No contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins</li> <li>▪ No inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contestant</li> <li>▪ No cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing.</li> </ul>

Any and all standards included may be tested in any competition.</li> <li>▪ In conjunction with National Standards, violations may result in student loss of contest.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Resume</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ All SkillsUSA Ohio State Championship Contest will require a short interview component. Students should be prepared with basic job interview skills.</li> <li>▪ All contestants must have a hard copy of a one (1) page personal resume.</li> </ul>
