Clothing	Official Dress: Official SkillsUSA red blazer, white shirt, black pants or skirt, and black dress shoes. Black socks must be worn with pants and nylons must be worn with a skirt (either skin-tone or black). Males must wear a black tie. OR
	School Uniform appropriate to the contest: Professional attire worn in the classroom such as a criminal justice uniform, chef attire, health scrubs or cosmetology scrubs with all identifiers covered. This includes shoes. Note: Contestants must wear their official contest clothing to the contest orientation meeting.
Testing	 Students should be prepared to take a SkillsUSA written knowledge test. (Required for all contestants prior to contest day)
